Our Competition Performance Team Program aims to develop the fundamental performance skills to enhance a budding dancer.

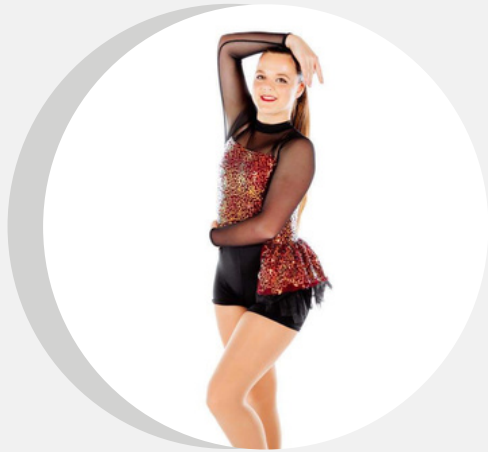

Versatility

This program is designed to be over 3-4 Saturday rehearsals per term. This allows students plenty of weekly time to continue their dance training, manage their school commitments and other extra curricular activities. Students are expected to attend 80% of all classes for the year and the mutual dedication to dance and other activities is expected.



Professional & Supportive

We train our students in a professional manner guiding them to develop artistry and skills that will help them in the future. We believe in the whole child and our team always consider the child emotionally throughout their dance experience with us. Our students are often recognised for their professionalism, support and team spirit.



Opportunities

Students can undertake solos, duos and trios as an extension on their training. Students are able to take up performance opportunities at fundraisers, stage shows & local events.

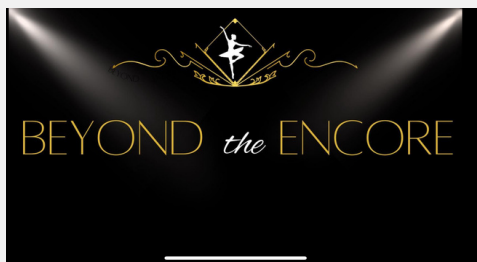

IMPORTANT NOTE!!

Competitions are subject to change based on troupe readiness, competition age breakdowns or changes, suitability to our routines etc. There will be NO DISCUSSION as to why troupes will/will not attend and this is at the discretion solely of teachers and Island Dance management.

Costumes will also be required for dance competitions and these will be used all year at competitions and events. Where possible, costumes will be recycled annually to reduce costs to families.

2024 Team Requirements

Commitment

Commitment is a huge part of being in a team. You must be aware of the termly rehearsal schedule and attend these Performance Team rehearsals, as well as your weekly regular lessons. Naturally things do crop up, and from time to time your child may miss a lesson. I do understand and work with families around this, however you must inform Miss Marie ASAP should this occur.

A commitment must also be made for the above Eisteddfods and Performances.

It is quite disruptive for the students to have to re-block routines, and work around the absence of their fellow teammates. Being on time and in attendance for rehearsals and performances is a must.

Lesson Requirements

Naturally students that are part of the Performance Team must have regular lessons to support the techniques of dance required to be part of an elite team. The more lessons your child does the stronger and more confident a dancer they become.

Students participating in the performance team must do **JAZZ** alongside a minimum of one other genre.

2024 Team Costs

Annual Cost

Being part of any Performance Team has costs involved.

PRICING - \$600 (exclusive of GST) per performer

Some students may also qualify for more than 1 Performance Team group for certain routines. (eg. 8 yrs & under, as well as 10 yrs & under.)

Should this occur and you wish to proceed with both Performance Team groups then the 2nd Performance Team group will be free. This will be Miss Marie's decision for your child to be in the double Performance Team.

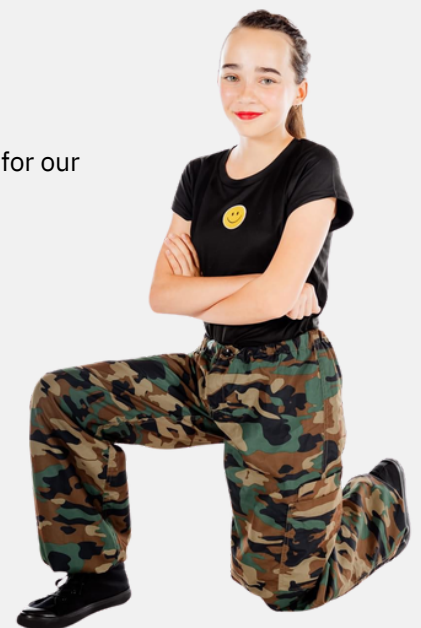


Inclusions

- Competition Backstage Dancer Pass (value between \$10-\$30 per dancer/per competition)

- Dancer Insurance
- Official Music Downloads and Edits
- Tailored Competition Choreography
- Costume Hire x 1 (additional routines which may be added throughout the year for our teams will be charged at \$40 per costume)

Dancers must provide

- Body Stocking/Appropriate Undergarments
- Dance Shoes (as required)

Students with incorrect Uniform/Costume/Stockings and Shoes will not be able to participate in class or performances. No refunds will be given for missed classes. Schedules are subject to change. Island Dance reserves the right to provide a substitute instructors if the regularly scheduled instructor is ill or otherwise unable to instruct the classes.
