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1. Enrolment Terms

- Enrolment is on annual basis unless otherwise agreed by the Parties.
- Enrolments are for the whole of a year and are invoiced either monthly/termly as stipulated upon completion of enrolment form.
- Enrolments made during the year do not rollover in to the following year.
- An annual non-refundable enrolment fee of \$35 is payable upon enrolment which covers insurances, administrative and extra costs relating to dance tuition.
- Re-enrolment is required by all students at the commencement of each year.
- The yearly registration fee covers music licensing and insurances and is payable with your first term of fees. It is a non-refundable annual fee and is due along with tuition when registering for class.

2. Term Dates

- Term 1: Monday 4 February - Saturday 6 April (9 weeks)
- Term 2: Tuesday 23 April - Saturday 30 June (10 weeks)
- Term 3: Monday 15 July - Saturday 21 September (10 weeks)
- Term 4: Tuesday 8 October - Saturday 7 December (9 weeks)

3. Payment Methods and Fees

- Island Dance shall only accept payments via direct deposit.
- Island Dance will not accept cash payments.
- Uniform purchases may be made via direct deposit or EFTPOS* facilities within the studio.
- All fees MUST be paid by the due date on the Invoice. Fees are invoiced on a month by month/termly basis and are charged in advance.
- An invoice detailing the number of lessons and fees will be e-mailed to the designated email account provide at time of enrolment.
- All fees are payable by the date stated on the invoice.
- Where a student commences lessons during the block, an invoice will be e-mailed and fees are payable immediately.
- Where a student increases the number of classes they attend, the fees will be adjusted and any additional amounts will be due within 7 days of receipt of the revised invoice.
- If you have not received an invoice or your invoice is incorrect, it is your responsibility to inform Island Dance immediately.
- 10% GST shall be added to all invoices.
- Where fees remain outstanding without prior arrangement with Island Dance for more than 28 days. The student may not be permitted to attend classes or studio activities until outstanding fees have been paid.

* Island Dance shall charge a Merchant Service Charge Fee for any transaction

4. Late Payments

- A late payment/administration fee of \$10 will be charged where invoices are not paid by the due date.
- Continuous late payments will result in your child being unable to participate in class.

5. Fee Complaints

- For all fee complaints outside these terms and conditions please contact Miss Marie.

6. Debt Recovery

- Island Dance reserves its rights to commence debt recovery through a Debt Collection Agency where a Student is more than 60 days late in paying an Invoice.



7. Refunds

- Refunds will only be made where the Island Dance cancels a class and no alternant class can be provided or where a student has a long term illness or long term injury.
- All other refunds will be at the discretion on Island Dance or otherwise permitted by Law.

8. Missed Class

- If a class is missed due to holiday or illness make up lessons may be offered (subject to availability). These classes are to be arranged with Miss Marie and are to be attended within two months of absence.
- It is the sole responsibility the Student to arrange a make-up class within 28 days of the missed class.
- Island Dance is not required to provide a make-up class where are request to have a make-up class is made more than 28 days after the missed class.
- No refunds or discounts or credits are given for missed classes for any reason.

9. Cancelled Class by Island Dance

- Where Island Dance cancels a class for any reason Island Dance in its sole discretion will decide whether it is appropriate to offer a make-up class or provide an alternative.

10. Cancellation of Enrolment by Island Dance

Your enrolment with Island Dance will be cancelled where any of the following occurs;

- while any of our Invoices remain unpaid,
- if You fail to comply with any reasonable direction issued by any staff member of Island Dance which compromises our ability to provide our Services to Students or compromises the safety and welfare of others Students of Island Dance,
- for any other reason outside our control which has the effect of compromising our ability to perform the Services within the required timeframe, and
- if in our sole discretion Island Dance considers it is no longer appropriate to provide the Services to You.

11. Cancellation of Enrolment by student

- You may cancel your enrolment by one month's written notice.
- The cancellation will take effect on the last day of the month you are currently enrolled.
- Full payment is required to be made until the end of the completion of the month or at an earlier stage at the sole discretion of Island Dance.
- No refund of enrolment fees shall be granted.

12. Change of Classes

- You may change your classes by written notice at any time.
- Notice not received prior to the 20th of the month will result in the student still being liable for full payment of invoice.

13. Emergency Closures and Change of Timetable

- Fees shall not refunded if classes are cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- A makeup lesson may be offered at the discretion of Island Dance.
- Island Dance reserves the right to change the timetable without prior notice.

14. Holiday Closures

- Island Dance shall be closed during public holidays and school holidays unless otherwise stated.
- Fees shall be adjusted for all closures.



15. Parking

- Island Dance at no time provides parking facilities to students, parents/guardians and visitors.
- Island dance takes no responsibility for any damage, theft or infringements while parking to attending Island Dance.

16. Lost Property

- Island Dance does not accept responsibility for loss or damage to personal property.
- All uniform items are named.
- Any items found will be placed in lost property box and it shall be the student's responsibility to retrieve all items.
- Any items that are not claimed by the end of the term will be disposed of.

17. Communication

- It is the responsibility of the parents/guardians to read all relevant information sent via email or posted on closed parents Facebook page.
- Email communication or Facebook messenger is the preferred method of communication to Island Dance.

18. Child Protection

- Island Dance is committed to delivering quality dance experiences in a safe encouraging environment that enables Island Dance students to learn and develop.
- Island Dance is committed to protect from harm and the safeguard all Island Dance students who attend all classes/activities.
- All staff working with Island Dance hold a valid Blue Card.
- In situations where greater supervision of children is required (e.g. dance displays, events), an appropriate ratio of adults will be in place.
- Parents/guardians and siblings must remain in the waiting area during class. Parents can observe class during designated observation events only.
- Only students are allowed in the Changing room. Parents/guardians who need to change their child must do so in the restroom.

19. Equal Opportunities

- Island Dance is an equal opportunities organisation and has open access to classes/activities for Island Dance students, regardless of sex, sexual orientation, marital status, religion, social-economic background, colour, race, nationality, ethnic origin, age or disability.

20. Physical Contact

- Due to the nature of dance, the student may have to be physically moved into position to enable them to "feel" the correct positioning before muscle memory develops.
- Teachers will however only use physical contact for correctional purposes or support and will aim to seek permission from the individual before physical contact is made.
- Island Dance staff may be required to assist with changing when concerts/events are taking place, this will only occur if the individual is in need of help or unable to change themselves.

21. Training/Injury

- All parents/guardians acknowledge dance is a physical activity where injury may occur whilst participating.
- Island Dance shall take no responsibility for injuries sustained during classes, performances or workshops.
- At enrolment and prior to commencing any class parents/guardians are required to inform Island Dance staff their child is physically and mentally fit to participate.
- Island Dance staff shall ensure parents/guardians are informed of any injury sustained during class and issue the parent with a copy of an incident/ injury report.



- Island Dance Staff understand the dangers of excessive training and will not push individuals against their will.
- Classes will be structured appropriately relating to the level and ability within the class and will recognised the developmental needs and capacity of Island Dance students.
- Island Dance shall take appropriate steps to ensure that all Island Dance students are not exposed to reasonably foreseeable risk of injury to their physical or mental health and wellbeing.
- All Island Dance staff are Emergency First Aid trained should an injury/incident occur.
- Island Dance shall have no responsibility for any injury sustained to parents/guardians or visitors while attending the Island Dance studios.

22. Fitness to Participate

- Island Dance provides the Services on the assumption that the Student is fit to participate in the Dance Classes.
- By accepting this Agreement, the parent/guardian confirms the student is fit to participate in the Dance Classes.

23. Before/After Class

- All students are required to be within the studio dresses and ready to commence class at least ten minutes prior.
- All students must be collected promptly from class.
- All students are the responsibility of the school for the duration of the class only.
- Before and after class is the responsibility of the parents/guardians.
- All children are to be collected from inside the studio, under no circumstances are the children permitted to wait on the street.

24. Breaks and Water

- During all classes, adequate rest and drink breaks shall be provided.
- Children are required to ensure they attend all classes with a full water bottle.
- No soft drinks, juices, or alike are to be brought into classes.
- No food is to be consumed during class's breaks unless required by medical certificate.

25. Toilet Policy

- Parents and/or Guardians are required to ensure the child/children of there care goes to the toilet before each class.
- Where a parent or guardian believes his or her child/children may not complete a class without a toilet break parents are to remain in the waiting room of the studio and assist the child where necessary.
- Island dance staff are not permitted to leave class to assist student(s) to the toilet.

26. Dance Attire and Hair

At Island Dance we pride ourselves in having uniformity and cooperation when it comes to our dress and Hair code.

Students, parents and/or guardians are required at all times to;

- refer to the uniform requirement page for what items are required for each class. All items can be ordered via the website;
- keep up to date with the dress code for each class your child/children is/are enrolled in;
- ensure full payment for products are made prior to delivery. At no time shall any uniform be ordered until full payment is made;
- ensure hair is neat and pulled back out of the face or in a bun for all genres;
- ensure hair is neat and groomed at all times;
- wear beads, barrettes, hair balls or similar items to be worn to any Island dance class;

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- ensure jewellery is not worn in any class or performance. Please remove bracelets, watches, rings & necklaces before entering your classroom, and
- to ensure no long or fake finger/toe nails. Nails must be sports length, and clear nail polish only on finger and toes is permitted during all performances, photo shoots, and productions.

27. Student Conduct

Island Dance is committed to providing an enjoyable experience for all Students.

Students shall at all times;

- not Intimidation, discrimination, harassment or threats by a student or students towards Student, Parents/Guardians, or any employees or sub-contractors or third parties attending Island Dance will not be tolerated;
- ensure the above mentioned, extends to those behaviours occurring at any location attended by Island Dance and during any performances (including before the commencement of any performance and after any performance) made by Students of Island Dance;
- at no time is the following permitted in any island dance class room;
 - Chewing gum.
 - Toys.
 - Jewellery.
 - Food or drink other than Water bottles.
 - Bags.
 - Shoes or thongs other than required dance shoes.
- must present to the studios in a tidy and well-groomed manner;
- be dressed appropriately for class and for health/hygiene ensure hair is tied back for class;
- present to class in a tidy and well-groomed manner with hair tied back neatly off the face. Ballet buns are required for all ballet classes;
- dance uniforms and dance shoes must be worn for classes, where specified. School uniform is not appropriate dance attire and therefore not permitted. Teachers may refuse entry to dancers not groomed appropriately;
- follow all reasonable instructions and guidance from Island Dance staff and volunteers;
- at no time leave the facility without written consent provided to Island Dance by parents/guardians;
- accept correction and work to the best of their individual ability during all classes;
- treat Island Dance studios, studio equipment and facilities with respect;
- ensure all rubbish is placed in bins provided and clean up after yourself;
- ensure mobile phones are switched off or on silent mode and are not to be used during classes;
- ask for help if you need it;
- arrive at least five minutes prior to a scheduled class, and
- understand latecomers may be refused entry, due to the risk of injury.

28. Parents, Careers and Guardians Conduct

Island Dance is committed to providing an enjoyable experience for all Students.

Parents and/or guardians shall at all times;

- understand and support Island Dances approach to dance by encouraging children to show commitment and positivity while working to the best of their own ability;
- ensure their child is physically and mentally fit before participating in class;
- inform Island Dance staff if their child is suffering any physically and mentally illness that may pose risk to their wellbeing;
- parents/guardians are required to ensure contact is made at least two hours prior to the commencement of class when a student is to be absent;
- a medical certificate shall be required where a makeup lesson is to be provided;
- accept and praise their child's individual abilities and achievements;



- accept and respect the professional opinion and experience of Island Dance staff;
- inform staff immediately of any changes in personal details or information related to participation in class;
- demonstrate respect for teachers, parents/guardians, staff and other students at all times;
- arrive at least five minutes prior to a scheduled class;
- understand latecomers may be refused entry, due to the risk of injury;
- ensure dance uniforms and dance shoes are worn for classes, where specified;
- school uniforms or casual attire will not be permitted. Teachers may refuse entry to students not groomed appropriately;
- present to the studios in a tidy and well-groomed manner;
- ensure your child/children have a clearly named bottle of water to every class;
- honour prior commitments made to the studio by attending classes, rehearsals and performances above other social events;
- serve as a role model to younger dancers at all times, including appropriate language and behaviour;
- put rubbish in the bins provided and clean up after yourself while at the studios.
- show respect and care for studio equipment and facilities;
- take responsibility to read email updates and keep up-to-date with current activities and important information;
- ensure siblings are supervised at all times, equipment is treated with care and the waiting areas are left tidy;
- refrain from entering either dance studio unless invited by a teacher. This includes studios not in use;
- refrain from taking photographs or video without permission;
- respect our approach to establishing and maintaining professional relationships with our students and parents/guardians by ensuring all contact is made via the office in person, by phone or email;
- refraining from direct communication with staff via personal email, text, phone or social media unless on platforms managed directly by Island Dance (e.g. a private Facebook group)
- raise any concerns with Island Dance Principle/Director;
- exhibit behaviours with children which may be construed as unnecessarily physical (for example inappropriate sitting on laps);
- put children at risk of abuse (for example, by locking doors);
- do things of a personal nature that a child can do for themselves, such as toileting or changing clothes;
- engage in open discussions of a mature or adult nature in the presence of children (for example, personal social activities);
- use inappropriate language in the presence of children;
- express personal views on cultures, race or sexuality in the presence of children;
- discriminate against any child, including because of culture, race, ethnicity or disability, and
- have any online contact with a child or their family (unless necessary, for example in a Facebook Group managed by Island Dance); ignore or disregard any suspected or disclosed child abuse.

29. Staff and Volunteer Conduct

Island Dance staff and volunteers shall at all times:

- treat all students equally and, with respect and dignity;
- treat all parents/guardians, visitors with respect;
- ensure at all times they portray a suitable role models for student;
- refrain from smoking, drinking alcohol or using inappropriate language in the company of students, parents/guardians and visitors;
- ensure they build balanced relationships with all students and will not have inappropriate physical or verbal contact with students;
- at all times give enthusiastic and constructive feedback and not negative criticism and will not show favouritism to any individual or resort to bullying tactics as a form of control;



- incorporate where appropriate pairs and group activities to encourage student communicational skills and team working skills;
- maintain a high level of behaviour and discipline in the studio; and
- be vigilant to incidents of intimidation or bullying.
- develop any 'special' relationships with children that could be seen as favouritism (for example, the offering of gifts or special treatment for specific children);
- exhibit behaviours with children which may be construed as unnecessarily physical (for example inappropriate sitting on laps);
- put children at risk of abuse (for example, by locking doors);
- do things of a personal nature that a child can do for themselves, such as toileting or changing clothes;
- engage in open discussions of a mature or adult nature in the presence of children (for example, personal social activities);
- use inappropriate language in the presence of children;
- express personal views on cultures, race or sexuality in the presence of children;
- discriminate against any child, including because of culture, race, ethnicity or disability;
- have contact with a child or their family outside of our organisation without Island Dances knowledge and/or consent (for example, no babysitting). Accidental contact (such as seeing people in the street) is appropriate, and
- have any online contact with a child or their family (unless necessary, for example in a Facebook Group managed by Island Dance); ignore or disregard any suspected or disclosed child abuse.

30. Unacceptable Behaviour and Discipline

- General nuisance behaviour (e.g. lack of attention, disruption) will result in student(s) being given a verbal warning. If continued within class they may be asked to sit out from an exercise. Persistent disruption will be reported to parents/guardians.
- Inappropriate use of language and/or conversation will not be tolerated and will be dealt with via a verbal warning and if continued parental notification.
- If there is an allegation of bullying staff will speak to both parties to investigate the circumstances of the incidents. Verbal warnings may be given and parents/guardians informed of any incidents.
- If serious disruptive/aggressive/abusive behaviour parents/guardians will be contacted. After discussion with the parents/guardians, arrangements will be made to support the students. In extreme circumstances, where no reasonable solution can be made, then the disruptive student may be asked to leave the dance school.
- Bullying is completely unacceptable within Island Dance. This may be verbal, physical or mental abuse and can include gossiping, teasing, ignoring or excluding, spreading rumours or sending unpleasant text, email or social network messages. Such behaviour will be taken very seriously and investigated with parents/guardians involved where it is considered necessary. Students are encouraged to disclose incidents of bullying to staff or parents/guardians to deal with the matter effectively and efficiently. Island Dance aims to maintain a safe, caring and enjoyable environment for Island Dance students to enjoy dance and achieve their full potential.
- Island Dance students will continually make, break and mend friendships. Children will be encouraged to work with new peers within the group in turn make new friendships. Parents/guardians should be aware that personal dislikes and personality clashes may occur and cannot be avoided. However jealousy and rivalry are both unhealthy and unacceptable. Any malicious behaviour will not be tolerated.



31. Prohibition on Photograph and Video Recordings

- Due to our privacy obligations under State and Commonwealth legislation no photograph and video recordings of any classes or Student performances shall be permitted to be undertaken by any Students, parents, guardians or volunteers.
- Where a Students, parents, guardians or volunteers fails to comply with clause, the enrolment of the Student will be cancelled and the Student will not be permitted to attend Island Dance premises or attend any performance of Island Dance.
- Photograph and video recordings may only be undertaken where consent has been given by Island Dance Principle/Director.
- Where a breach in Island Dance's view may involve criminal conduct Island Dance reserves its right to inform the relevant law enforcement body of the incident.

32. Social Media

Students, parents, guardians, volunteers and staff are required at all times to;

- understand at no time permission is given to reveal any information that compromises Island Dance. This includes:
 - Sharing of personal information about the director, staff, students and/or their families.
 - Any proprietary information.
 - Any confidential information.
- claim or imply that they are speaking on behalf of Island Dance.
- use discretion when posting pictures, including those of other students at Island Dance.
- obey copyright laws.
- ensure nothing is posted that could compromise self-esteem of students attending Island Dance.
- no videos or photos of classes, rehearsals or competition performances;
- ensure no posts are made of any choreography in it's entirety. Island Dance owns the copyright to all choreography presented at the school.
- respect the law, including those laws governing defamation, discrimination, harassment, copyright and fair use.
- exercise particular caution when posts, images, or videos identifying children in your care;
- Island Dance may at times use photographs of children for social media purposes;
- understand any comments or posts perceived to be obscene, defamatory, threatening, harassing, discriminatory or hateful towards Island Dance staff, students or families may be subject to Island Dance disciplinary action and/or legal action;
- when engaging on Social Media while identifying as an Island Dance student, parents/guardians, volunteer or employee, must only do so with integrity and respect;
- ensure content revealing or referring to studio information is not to be shared online;
- ensure intellectual property laws (for example, costume design and choreography), are to be observed by all studio patrons when posting online. This includes but not limited to manuals, forms, handbooks, and syllabus, etc;
- while affiliated with Island Dance, (for example, images of your child in Island Dance uniform) we will not tolerate any posts that are racially, sexually, physically or religiously offensive;
- understand Island Dance discourages persons becoming 'friends' or 'followers' on Social Media, unless there is an existing relationship;
- understand Island Dance considers all studio members to be family and as such feel the obligation to respect and monitor personal boundaries;
- not engaging in 'hidden' or 'private' groups formed for the specific purpose of discussing studio matters will be encouraged to join our closed Facebook group for public discussion and warned against discussing Island Dance matters in their private online groups;
- post photos or videos taken from performances or rehearsals online;
- no photographs / videos that feature Island Dance students other than your own online without the proven consent of their parent/guardian, and
- ensure no identifying information of any featured minors - including names, ages or location.



- comments about other schools, teachers, or events, including competitions, conventions and performances.

33. Class Observation

- Island Dance may open classes to observation by parents/guardians twice a year or at the discretion of Island Dance.
- Pictures during class observations shall be at the discretion of Island dance and parents/guardians must seek approval prior.

34. Concert and Productions

- It is not compulsory for a student to be involved in the annual performances, however it is encouraged.
- Each student participating in the concert is required to attend the all rehearsal and photo shoots.
- No parents/guardians shall be able to assist backstage or within dressing rooms without a current copy of their Blue Card being provided to Island Dance.
- Concert tickets will be denied to any family with outstanding accounts.

35. Property and intellectual property

- Choreography, costuming and studio information remain the intellectual property of Island Dance and may not be reproduced, sold or by any students, parents or staff without permission of the Director/s.

36. Information Security

- Island Dance is able to send and receive electronic mail. However, as such mail is not secure it may be copied, recorded, read or interfered with by third parties while in transit. If You ask us to transmit any document electronically, You release us from any claim You may have as a result of any unauthorised copying, recording, reading or interference with that document after transmission, for any delay or non-delivery of any document and for any damage caused to Your system or any files by a transfer.

37. Waiver and Release

- By enrolling as an enrolling student over the age of 18, parent or guardian of a child/children under 18 years of age you understand that you have enrolled your yourself, child or children in a program of physical activity with Island Dance.
- As an as an enrolling student over the age of 18, parent or guardian of a child/children under 18 years of age have disclosed and provided all existing and pre-existing injuries and illnesses including medication to Island Dance. Where an existing or pre-existing injury or illness exists you as an individual, parent or guardian are required to request via email or within the studio a copy of Island Dances Medical history acknowledgement form.
- Where an injury is to be sustained or where medication is prescribed during an enrolment period you as the individual, parent or guardian must obtain, complete and return a copy of Island Dances Medical history acknowledgement form prior to attending the next class.
- As an individual, parent or guardian you acknowledge that Island Dance shall at no time pressure to a student to physically exert themselves beyond my/his/her capacity and it is the individual, parent or guardians responsibility to use personal judgment concerning the degree of their participation in all activities.
- As an enrolling student over the age of 18, parent or guardian of a child/children under 18 years of age acknowledge and agree to all sections of these terms and conditions and agree Island Dance at any time reserves the right to add or alter information within these terms and conditions. Where additions or alterations are made I understand notice of these changes will be issued via electronic mail and will form part of these terms and conditions.
- As an enrolling student over the age of 18, parent or guardian of a child/children under 18 years of age acknowledge that if you believe event conditions are unsafe, you will immediately discontinue participation in such activities.



- As an enrolling student over the age of 18, parent or guardian of a child/children under 18 years of age fully understand and acknowledge that the activities provided by Island Dance involve risks of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death, which may be caused by my own actions, inactions, those of others participating in the event, the conditions in which the event takes place, or the negligence of the “releases” and that there may be other risks either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time;
- As an enrolling student over the age of 18, parent or guardian of a child/children under 18 years of age fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, cost, and damages incurred as a result of participation of an individual, child or children in the activities.
- The enrolling student over the age of 18, parent or guardian of a child/children under 18 years of age shall indemnify Island Dance, its employees and agents against any liability, loss or damage (including but not limited to for any personal injury, property damage/loss or wrongful death), costs (including the costs of any settlement and legal costs and expenses on a solicitor and own client basis) and expenses arising out of or in connection with a wilful default or unlawful or negligent act or omission by the Student or Parents/guardians.
- As an enrolling student over the age of 18, parent or guardian of a child/children under 18 years of age hereby release, discharge, and covenant not to sue Island Dance, their respective administrators, agents, officers, managers, members, volunteers, and employees, other participants (the “Releases”) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages, on the child/children’s account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence or the Releases or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations and future agree that if, despite this release, waiver of liability, and assumption of risk.
- As an enrolling student over the age of 18, parent or guardian of a child/children under 18 years of age makes a claim against any of the Releases, you shall indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the Releases from any loss, liability, damage, or cost, which any may incur as the result of such claim, including without limitation litigation expenses and attorneys’ fees. you have read the Release and Waiver and understand that you have given up substantial rights by signing it freely and without any inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect.
- As an enrolling student over the age of 18, parent or guardian of a child/children under 18 years of age give Island Dance permission to photograph my child/children or myself and you understand that pictures maybe used for publicity purpose including but not limited to brochures, advertisements, social media and Island Dance’ website. Names are not used in any promotional material.
- As an enrolling student over the age of 18, parent or guardian of a child/children under 18 years of age acknowledge that I understand the nature of the activities and that individual, child or children are in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such activities and that you as an individual, parent or guardian are authorized to sign this Release and Waiver.

38. Applicable Laws and Legislation
